# Madelyn & Norman

Madelyn needs to change and growNorman needs to let go of the past and his ego

Their EMOTIONAL SECRETS: the troubles underlying who they are and the OBSTACLES to love:

# She FEARS that others will ENDANGER her

has not had a serious relationship since her divorce 20 years ago content with her solitary safe life (not repressed or frustrated)

#### He FEARS CRITICISM

so he finds fault with others

each helps/provokes the other to do the thing they need

(Madelyn SEES THROUGH Norman and POKES HOLES in his ego)

(Norman comes to BELIEVE in Madelyn and SUPPORT her a new role for him)

# this romance ENDS with a BEGINNING:

they get to the point where they want to <u>try</u> - To go out on a date, or something

# The central action is SOLVING:

- investigating
  - puzzling
  - reasoning

They want to solve the mystery/find the killer BECAUSE the killer is after THEM

# story is a cascade of FUMBLES

the characters are all MAKING MISTAKES
(based in their needs)
that force them into CONFLICT

A limited hour-long series (potential for sequels/other seasons...?)

#### **CHARACTERS**

#### **Norman Murch**

A pissed-off journalist in his 50s.

working through his resentment at being forcibly-retired from the changing journalism-industry (and world) by writing a book analyzing what's gone wrong with the world since crowdsourcing was invented.

Dealing with the fact that he couldn't adapt to changing times by writing a book CRITIQUING changing times.

#### Norman wants to To FIX The Past

make it NOT HIS FAULT
to get the world to agree he was not wrong
(He <u>THINKS</u> he's SAVING the FUTURE by EXPLAINING how others were
WRONG IN THE PAST)

# his STORY IS ABOUT learning to LET GO of undoing the past and DOING BETTER IN THE PRESENT

# **Madelyn Morrison**

Dead George's Ex a data-analysis supervisor for a giant financial services company (having her have to explain it to people will be fun)

> <u>practical</u> and <u>optimistic</u> and <u>engaged</u> <u>never give up</u> - keep trying

# Madelyn wants to change her life - to grow and be better

NOT to stay stuck and decaying Has just decided to study to be EMT or THERAPIST

Born 1972 Married 1991 at 19

# **Zena Morano**

Zoomer - 20 years old, born in 2001

Takes over the podcast
hypes the investigation
turns out to be the killer

saw an opportunity and took it, selfishly.

Out of DESPAIR: world is a mess, so I want for me.

SAYS trying to MAKE A DIFFERENCE - to do Something GOOD for the world but

his secret motive is ANGER
"You (older) people fucked up the world and we are going to take
over and fix it!"

# **Pre-Post-Apocalyptic**

#### **ALL ABOUT ATTENTION**

knows THE MURDER will make George interesting to the public! (like a dead painter)

ALSO ROMCOM SIDEKICK for BOTH Madelyn & Norman loveable because HE TELLS THE TRUTH - insightful

Zena is the only one who is FULL TIME into the podcast and the case. He has bet everything on it

But it is not his first media project - so his past should be revealing of his nature

He was an influencer for a while

Maybe also into prank and outrage?

DISCOVERY of his past online identities is a turning point? Or it is known from the start and helps make him seem ridiculous and HARMLESS?

# George Roizman

Dead podcaster a sad desperate nut

#### **Elmore Deakins**

Actual retired serial killer who is being FRAMED for the George's murder

And the new interest stirred up by this frame threatens to identify him
So he is trying to scare them threaten them and when that doesn't work he has to KILL THEM

# **Elswit Khondji**

a conspiracy theorist they turn out to be a good person, though

#### Lubezki Andrews

Sleuthing to **distract** from personal unhappiness because in life there is something bad that has NO supervillain ? disease? Or is caring for someone? Or it's the JOB: is a nurse? Team Member: Crime Victim

# DETECTIVE 5 someone who is OUT FOR JUSTICE

believe that good people getting together can stop bad people.

# The Major Moves

#### **Episode 1**

George Podcast-Hunting - says new evidence /Killed Meet Madelyn & Cops & Investigation/Zena Trying To Get Files Meet Norman, in Zoom Group - Zena steers them to rob Madelyn for Ex's Files

Norman intervenes to protect Madelyn
Madelyn & Norman Spend Night Together - make love
Mad & Norm next day: Getting To Know You
Zena Shows Up - Gets Access To Files

#### **THEMES**

#### CONFRONTING this awful thing that we think is entertaining

We Love Serial Killers: WHY the fuck?
They're uniquely evil: a human monster.
They're a story.

They're UNLIKELY to be our real problem.
